Solutions:

- Make sure antivirus is disabled and/or the JIN folder is whitelisted as exclusion
- Make sure anticheats like vanguard are disabled
- Make sure there are no recent windows updates
 - You can uninstall windows updates 1 by 1 until it works
 - Once you have a working JIN installation you can use update-blocker to prevent windows from updating again.

- Run Vt-check.exe and make sure it is all green
 - o If you see red errors/messages in VT-Check you need to work on that
 - More info here in this document
- Disable Hyper-V and enable Virtualization from BIOS
- Disable TPM and Secure Boot in BIOS
- In windows: Tamper protection disabled & Memory integrity disabled
- Open CMD as admin and use the following command and restart your pc after: bcdedit /set hypervisorlaunchtype off
- Make sure that HyperV/VMWare/Docker or any virtualization software as well as anticheats (Vanguard, EasyAntiCheat, BattleEyes) are disabled

Solutions:

- Make sure your game's auto updates are off
- Start the game and see if the tool can load fine
- Make sure all pending updates are finished (Start game manually, restart pc)
- Make sure JIN is updated for the current game version build
 - \circ You might have to wait up to 24 hours for JIN team to update
 - \circ $\:$ If you disable auto-updates you can avoid this
